



Medicare will cover skilled care only if all of the following are true:

1. If you have Medicare Part A* hospital insurance and have some days left in your benefit period.
2. If you have a qualifying hospital stay, which means that an inpatient hospital for 3 consecutive days or more than that. You must have to enter the SNF within a short period of time after leaving the hospital.
3. If your doctor has ordered for the services that you need for the SNF care. This care includes the services of skills of professional personnel such as an occupational therapist, physical therapist, registered nurses, licensed practical nurses and speech-language pathologist etc.
4. If you require skilled and professional care on a daily basis, and the service must be of that type which can only be provided in SNF on an inpatient basis.
5. You would need these type of skilled services for a medical condition that:
 - was being treated during a qualifying 3-day hospital stay, or either
 - being started while you were getting an SNF care for a condition that would have been treated during a 3 day qualifying hospital day

The daily rate for the skilled nursing care includes board and room:

- Three meals would be served per day in rehabilitation dining or main dining facility
- Snacks, tray devices
- The special diets upon the instructions of physicians
- Daily assistance of daily activities like bathing, ambulation, dressing or personal hygiene and needs
- The daily housekeep service
- The bathroom and bed linens(very less incontinent care linens)
- Administration of medications that are prescribed either by alternate or attending physician
- The 24-hour supervision that is licensed by nursing personnel (R.N. or L.P.N.) or certified nurse assistants
- Compete for assistance while feeding
- Properly planned activities
- The occupational and recreational programs
- Reviewing drug regimen
- Consultation regarding social services
- The referral service and discharge planning
- The rooms are furnished in proper accordance with the federal regulatory and state agencies

SPECIALIZED CARE PROCEDURES, THERAPY, RESIDENT CARE MEDICAL, OCCUPATIONAL
THERAPY, DENTIST VISIT CHARGES, DIAGNOSTICS TEST INCONTINENT CARE SUPPLIES,
RESPIRATORY THERAPY, PHYSICAL THERAPY, OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY MEDICATION AND
THE SUNDRY ITEMS, PHYSICIAN VISIT CHARGES.
